WASTE GUIDELINES FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF THE ARCHIPELAGO



FOR BLUE BINS



- Plastic bottles and containers (Keep lids on). Please rinse.
- Food and beverage cans (Place lids inside the food cans). Please rinse.
- Glass bottles and jars (Keep lids on). Please rinse.
- Empty aerosol cans (Lids off and can empty).
- Plastic film and outer wrap, bread bags, candy wrappers, plastic bags, etc.
- Aluminum tin, foil, pie pans, and grocery store styrofoam. Please clean.
- Paint cans (Empty dry paint cans with lids off).

HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE



- Household garbage waste.
- Waxed paper and waxed cardboard.
- Tissue and paper towels.
- Packing styrofoam.
- Broken lightbulbs.
- Food-soiled cartons.
- Coat hangers.
- Plastic eating utensils.
- Mirrors and broken windows.
- Ceramics and glass drinkware.
- Elastic bands and string.
- Durable hard plastic toys.

FOR GREY BINS



- Newspaper, paper flyers, catalogues, and telephone books.
- Junk mail, office paper and books.
- Milk and juice cartons.
- Tetra packs and juice boxes.
- Boxboard - cereal boxes, cracker boxes, tissue boxes, etc. Please flatten.
- Corrugated cardboard boxes. Please flatten.
